Korean support sees Industrial Waste Management Progress

Knowledge Sharing Program (KSP) has strengthened the capacities of small and medium enterprises (SMEs), as well as large factories. In 2021, Cambodian Ministry of Industry, Science, Technology, and Innovation submitted the KSP proposal, which Korean Ministry of Economy and Finance (MOEF) and Korea Development Institute (KDI) reviewed, later confirming that it would be referred to as the "Strengthening SMEs and Large Factory Capacity on Waste Management" project. Since its launch in Phnom Penh in October 2023, the KSP has included seminars and meetings in Phnom Penh and Seoul. This collaborative effort with Korea has already yielded impressive results, as discussed at the June 17 final reporting workshop, which presented several policy recommendations.
